The course, established in 1971 by Layton and Christine Ring, is for people interested in every aspect of early music.

It caters for students of all ages and experience, from elementary to advanced, with classes for Recorder (A415 and A440), Viol (A415), Lute, Baroque Strings (A415), Harpsichord and Solo Singing.

The many activities include technique classes, concerts, lectures and a wide variety of ensemble work, including trio sonatas, consorts, renaissance band, choir and baroque orchestra, dance and more.

The College of St Hild and St Bede is a constituent college of the University of Durham, within easy reach of the city centre and the bus and railway stations. The city, with its castle and unequalled Norman cathedral, is an ideal centre for tourism. We welcome players and non-players alike.

The St Hild and St Bede site is on many levels and, although the grounds are beautiful and extensive, they are very steep in many areas.

Students are accommodated in single study bedrooms with shared facilities. A small number of ensuite twin and single rooms are available at an extra charge, on a first-come, first-served basis.

Early application for all classes is advised and there is a discount for those applying before 1st April 2015.

Students should bring their own instruments to the course. If this is difficult, please consult the Secretary: a limited number of viols will be available for hire at a charge of £25, and loan of other instruments and bows can usually be arranged if requested before June. During the week, provision is made for repairs to stringed instruments and bows.


During the Week Jacks Pipes and Hammers tel. 01422 882751

DAILY PROGRAMME

MORNING

1st Session: Technique

The options will include Solo Bass Viol, Viol, Solo Recorder, Recorder, Singing, Baroque Strings, Harpsichord and Lute/Theorbo. It is preferable for students to stay with one chosen option for the whole week

2nd Session: Ensembles

This session provides opportunities for playing one to a part in consorts, Renaissance mixed ensembles, or trio sonatas, and for solo or ensemble singing; groups will be arranged according to ability and experience. If you wish to be considered for more than one option please show your preference on the application form. These groups can be changed during the week.

AFTERNOON

1st Session: Free except for Baroque Orchestra (2pm-3.30pm) and Choir (2.30pm-4pm).

2nd Session: Choice of Delights
A free-choice session including a wide
variety of activities such as: Viol Consorts,
Recorder Ensemble, Voices and Viols,

Renaissance Band, Lute Song, Plucked Instruments, Early Court Dancing, Division Recorder, and Facsimile. Wednesday afternoon is entirely free.

EVENING

There will be lectures, concerts (given by course tutors and students), a Ceilidh on Wednesday and a final concert by the choir and orchestra on Friday. This year the choir will prepare and perform two settings of the Sanctus by Bach, and Lift up your heads, o ye gates by Blow, and the orchestra Bach's Orchestral Suite in B minor.

BURSARIES AND HELP WITH FEES
